Event Cancellation Policy

Substitution:

Refunds:

- There will be no refunds on any cancellations once the sponsorship has been confirmed as marketing of the event will have commenced.
- Cancellation must be in writing and acknowledged by the event organiser.

Global pandemic (Covid and or similar)

- In the case where government imposed restrictions, resulting from a pandemic or similar event, limits the number of attendees to the Bean Counters Ball, sponsors/attendees will be given preference to attend in the order in which sponsorship was committed to (first in, first to attend) up to the allowed number of attendees.
- If government restrictions prevent the Bean Counters Ball to proceed in totality or if it becomes uneconomical to hold the Bean Counters Ball due to the imposed restrictions, the sponsorship/ attendees will roll over until such time as the Bean Counters Ball is able to proceed/be held or to the next calendar year's Bean Counters Ball if the restrictions prevent the Bean Counters Ball to take place in the same calendar year.
